

Premier Speedway Smoking Policy

This policy was approved by the Board of Management of the Premier Speedway Club at its meeting on Wednesday May 27, 2020

INTRODUCTION

The Premier Speedway Club does not allow smoking within the Premier Speedway venue, except for the three designated Smoking sites. One of which is located in the pit enclosure, with the two remaining areas located on either side of the complex.

All buildings, offices, corporate buildings either permanent or temporary are to be smoking free at all times.

PURPOSE OF THIS POLICY

The purpose of this policy is to ensure the Premier Speedway Club Committee and Club Members understand the Premier Speedway Club's position regarding smoking.

WHEN DOES THE POLICY APPLY?

This policy applies whenever the individual is taking part in activities under the Premier Speedway Club's jurisdiction. This includes all race meetings or associated events as promoted by the Premier Speedway Club including meetings, dinners and other Club functions as organized by the Premier Speedway Club.

Private behavior of members is not included in this policy as the Premier Speedway Club cannot be responsible for the behavior of our members outside the Club's jurisdiction.

WHO DOES THIS APPLY TO?

All Club Members, Employees and Visitors to the Premier Speedway Club.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The Premier Speedway Club will:

- Activate and comply with the policy.
- Promote the policy to everyone within the Premier Speedway Club.
- Promote and role model expected standards of behavior at all times.
- Respond to breaches of this policy discreetly and in a timely manner.

- Investigate all apparent, or alleged, breaches of this policy and take action after all relevant facts and circumstances are known.

Individuals Will:

- Comply with the policy.
- Promote and role model expected standards of behaviour at all times.
- Be responsible and accountable for their behavior.
- Honour our commitment to the health, safety and welfare of all of our members.
